Activities Childcare and Education Centre - £46,928

Towards an initiative which enhances the early education of children through practical outdoor activities.

Andover and District Partnership Trust - £38,000

Towards the salary of the Senior Project Worker to secure the long-term future of 'Stay and Play' which provides a family learning programme for disadvantaged adults.

Atlantic Council - £30,000

Towards the salary costs of an Education Director to promote the principle of citizenship and participation in the democratic process on a supra-national basis to the young people of today.
