Towards the salary of a Self-Advocacy Worker to provide services for adults with learning disabilities to help them obtain full rights as citizens and develop their abilities.

Afiya Trust - £40,000

Towards core costs over two years of work to achieve equity in health and social care provision for the black and ethnic minority population via community involvement and representation.

Age Concern, Hereford - £15,000

Towards the costs of a mobile day service for older people which offers a range of services including a transport service for the elderly living in rural areas.

Agewell in Sheffield - £63,388

Towards the salary of a Training Officer and associated costs of providing volunteer training for older people.

Towards the development costs of accredited training programmes for professionals working in the field of domestic violence.
