### Environment

#### Grants approved over £10,000

##### **Abney Park Cemetery Trust** - £51,675

Towards the salary over two years of an Education and Training Officer to provide opportunities for disadvantaged young people to learn in an urban nature reserve in London.

##### **Argyll & Bute Local Biodiversity Partnership** - £55,867

Towards the salary over three years of a Black Grouse Recovery Project Officer.

##### **Beulah United Reformed Church, Rhiwbina, Cardiff** - £13,525

Towards project costs to restore and conserve a green haven in the centre of a busy suburb for use by shoppers, the elderly and children attending a nursery.

##### **Biological Recording in Scotland** - £51,976

Towards the salary over three years of a Development Officer to increase participation in monitoring and enjoying wildlife by volunteers and the general public.

##### **Buglife** - £95,000

Towards the salaries and costs over three years of a Fundraiser and Administrator to establish a new invertebrate conservation organisation.

##### **Buried Treasure** - £50,625

Towards the salary of a Project Director to provide training, work experience and volunteer opportunities in organic horticulture in Bristol.

##### **Carntogher Community Association** - £36,888

Towards the costs over three years of a Project Officer to generate greater local appreciation of the landscape, environment and heritage of this rural community.

##### **Centre for Ecology and Hydrology** - £26,433

Towards the costs of analysing factors affecting bird breeding success and survival and to recommend improvements to the habitat of small woods and parks for birds.

##### **Clow Beck Children's Farm** - £44,000

Towards the salary over two years of a Project Manager at a farm in North Yorkshire which helps children to understand the value of sustainable living.

Towards the salary and costs over two years of a Community and Education Manager to initiate environmental projects with local communities.

##### **Community Scrap Scheme** - £24,000

Towards the costs over three years of a scheme to reduce the amount of re-useable waste materials being sent to landfill.

**Council for National Parks** - £13,369

Towards the salary of the Welsh Officer to strengthen the supporter base for the Council for National Parks in Wales.

**Cycle West** - £45,000

Towards the salary and costs over three years of the Director, working to help people to overcome the barriers to cycling.

**Devon Wildlife Trust** - £100,000

Towards the costs over two years of a project to conserve the reefs of Lyme Bay by establishing sustainable fisheries.

**Dorset Wildlife Trust** - £79,750

Towards the salaries over two years of two Project Officers who will establish youth and community groups to undertake practical and educational wildlife and environmental activities.

**Earthwatch** - £57,500

Towards developing four new UK conservation projects on fragile habitats and vulnerable species and providing opportunities for different sectors of the community to participate in volunteer work in the UK.

**Environmental Law Foundation** - £87,054

Towards the salary over three years and running costs of the advice and referral service and community outreach programme for those seeking legal solutions to environmental issues.

Towards the costs over three years of an information and education project to encourage the use of British native flora for biodiversity, restoration and creative conservation.

Towards the costs over two years of a communications strategy to increase understanding of sustainability issues in new sectors.

Towards the salary and costs over three years of a Public Affairs Director and the development of a wider membership base.

Towards the costs over three years of promoting environmental issues in public and private policy.

Towards the costs over two years of establishing new community tree planting schemes around the UK, with an emphasis on urban areas.
