Freshwater Biological Association - £90,000

Towards the cost over two years of the re-publication of the classic freshwater invertebrate guide and bespoke freshwater fauna on-line data recording module.

Marine Biological Association - £195,000

Towards research costs over three years designing artificial urban coastal habitats maximising biodiversity.

NERC Sea Mammal Research Unit - £49,023

Towards the salary of a research assistant and modifications to a photo identification programme for grey seals.

North of England Zoological Society - £17,254

Towards the cost of training for new regional volunteer wildlife recorders.

Roehampton University - £76,088

Towards the cost of a survey of groundwater organisms in Devon and Dorset and subsequent design of sampling protocol for other areas.
